Following Root Canal Treatment

Your tooth will no longer be sensitive to hot or cold but may become very <u>sensitive to bite</u>. Soreness to bite may be the most noticeable on days 3, 4, & 5 after the procedure. This will subside <u>gradually</u> over the next 10-15 days. We recommend taking 600mg. of Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) every 4-6 hours. If you cannot take Ibuprofen or Aspirin, Extra Strength Tylenol can be substituted.
