Following Today's Procedure

Your tooth will no longer be sensitive to hot or cold but may become very sensitive to bite. Soreness to bite may be the most noticeable on days 3, 4, & 5 after the procedure. This will subside gradually over the next 10-15 days. We recommend taking 600mg. of Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) every 4-6 hours. If you cannot take Ibuprofen or Aspirin, Extra Strength Tylenol can be substituted.

Always consult with your physician if you have any questions about our recommendations and your current medications.

A temporary filling has been placed in your tooth. Root canal treatment has NOT been completed. An additional appointment will be required to finish the root canal treatment.
